National Hockey Teams Face Off at UofD March 5-9 UofD Men's Hockey Team Enters as Fifth Seed

Dover, Del. (February 28, 2011) – The 2011 [American Collegiate Hockey Association](#) (ACHA) Men's Division I National Championship will be held at the [University of Delaware](#) (UofD) from March 5-9, 2011. Sponsored by [ING Direct](#) and co-hosted by the [Delaware Sports Commission](#), this five-day hockey tournament will feature 16 of the nation's top collegiate hockey teams. The UofD Men's Hockey Team, a fifth seed in the tournament, is a strong contender. UofD is slated to start this competition at 7:00 p.m. on March 5th at the [Fred Rust Ice Hockey Arena](#) against Robert Morris University.
